#### **Minutes**

Chairperson Adam Miller called the meeting to order at 8:30 AM. A quorum was present.

Greg Stemen moved to approve the Investment Subcommittee agenda for the August 27, 2024, meeting. The motion was seconded by Jeffry Volk.

Agenda was approved by voice vote.

## I. Minutes - Tuesday, May 28, 2024

Chairperson Miller called for questions or comments regarding the minutes of May 28, 2024.

Jeffry Volk moved to approve the minutes of the May 28, 2024, Investment Subcommittee meeting. The motion was seconded by Greg Stemen.

Minutes were approved by voice vote.

### III. Defined Benefit Plans Performance Q2 2024 Update – RIO

Scott Anderson gave an investment update on the PERS Defined Benefit plans as of March 31, 2024. Performance benchmark indices were reviewed. The annual inflation rate for July 2023 thru July 2024 was +2.9% based on the CPI. NDPERS' 10-year average return as of March 31, 2024, was 7.2% compared to the policy return of 6.6%. PERS actual and target asset allocations were reviewed. The year-to-date total PERS fund return of 4.2% less the policy benchmark return of 3.8% resulted in a total relative return of 0.4% as of May 31, 2024. The one-year total PERS fund return of 11.2% less the policy benchmark return of 11.0% resulted in a total relative return of 0.2% as of March 31, 2024. Total actual assets as of March 31, 2024, were \$4,302,807,000. Discussion took place.

#### IV. Asset Allocation Discussion - RIO

Scott Anderson presented information on asset allocation, Pension Fund Level studies and hiring an Asset Allocation Consultant. Discussion took place.

## V. Market Update & Performance - Callan

Perry Hopper presented a market update for the 2nd quarter of 2024. Perry noted the successful recordkeeper transition from TIAA to Empower, and implementation of the new investment structure as of July 1, 2024.

The investment structure for the 457 and 401(a) plans was reviewed. Both plans experienced positive investment gains in the second quarter. Both managers previously on the wait list, Templeton Global Bond and Allspring Growth, were removed as part of the transition to the new investment structure. No managers are currently on watch.

Perry Hopper and Craig Chaikin reviewed the plan investment fees in the new structure. Discussion took place.

## VI. Plan Review - Empower

Dave Ramirez with Empower presented the 2Q2024 plan review. The NDPERS Companion plan has 10,568 participants and assets of \$222,597,210. The NDPERS 401(a) Defined Contribution plan has 197 members and assets of \$23,586,938. Empower hosted four webinar sessions for members to introduce them to the available resources. The transition guide will be submitted by Empower to the Marcom competition. Discussion took place.

## VII. Annuity Lineup – Callan

Requirements of North Dakota House Bill 1040 were reviewed by Ben Taylor. Non-Guaranteed verses Guaranteed Solutions, options available to meet HB 1040, and a comparison of fixed account solutions were presented. Callan recommends selecting an option from Empower and New York Life. Discussion took place.

Tyler Erickson moved to recommend that Callan limit their analysis to the following four funds for consideration by the Board at the September meeting: Empower Investments Fixed Account Series, Empower Guaranteed Income Fund, New York Life Guaranteed Interest Account, and New York Life Insurance Company Anchor Account. The motion was seconded by Joe Morrissette.
